#### Support Measures GGG

The Göttingen Graduate School of Social Sciences provides support measures and scholarships for PhD students of social sciences. At the moment GGG offers new support for your qualification and networking activities as well as some grants with flexible application possibilities. #### Changes in GGG funding offers

From now one GGG emergency grants are not provided anymore. The [completion grant for international PhD](#) students of the DAAD as well as the [Family Oriented Completion Grant](#) of the GGG remain regular GGG funding opportunities.

The Family Oriented Completion Grant supports the reconciliation of family life/care with the successful completion of you PhD. Therefore the application needs to initially handed in at your faculty. If your faculty confirms a) that no other funding opportunities are available and b) no other reasons than childcare or care responsibilities yielded a prolonged dissertation process, your application will be proceeded to the GGG.

#### Courses offered by the SUB
